NURSING WING

Our residential nursing home is registered for 21 residents making it small and personable, with a dedicated, experienced staff team, many of who have worked at the home for many years. The nursing home specialises in providing palliative care for residents, as well as post operative care and respite care.

NEW EMI NURSING WING

Avalon Nursing Home opened a new dedicated EMI Nursing wing in October 2009 to provide specialist care for residents who require Nursing and who may have

have Dementia, Alzheimer's or Parkinson's. This dedicated wing has 12 large luxury rooms with en-suite wet rooms, a lounge, conservatory and a large garden, providing a vast experienced EMI team onsite at all times. The EMI wing boasts a glass wheelchair lift that gives easy access to the first floor bed rooms for all patients.

ENVIRONMENT

ACTIVITIES

The home Activity Co-ordinator is able to co-ordinate in-house activities and hobbies. The Activities follow seasonal events, celebrations or topical events. These themed events include trips to the library or Hampden Park. The home provides entertainment and social gatherings each month with shows, and singers performing at the home.



HOW TO GET TO AVALON



By Car

From London take the M25, M23, A23, A27 straight at all the round about for 12.6 miles, then take the A2270 Polegate bypass and follow the signs for Hampden Park. Nevill Avenue is located on the same road as the park.

By Bus

From the Town Centre there are regular buses to and from Hampden Park. Brassey Parade is the destination, then walk up Brassey Avenue. You walk till you come to a bend in the road and you will see the white fence which is Avalon Nursing Home.

By Train

Trains are twice an hour from Eastbourne Station.
